Your day to day

We are seeking a skilled and experienced Guest Services Groundskeeper to join our team. With time, our goal is for this role to grow into tending for kitchen and bush food gardens that are currently in planning phase as well. Responsibilities:

- Ground maintenance including mowing, pruning and general gardening.
- Remove weeds, debris, and litter from the grounds.
- Use power tools such as lawn mowers, hedge trimmers, and leaf blowers.
- Monitor and adjust irrigation systems as needed.
- Assist waste management and transfer general waste to the Mount Glorious Dump.
- Firewood prep.
- Minor property maintenance (e.g. installing a hook/changing light bulb etc)
- Perform other duties as assigned.

What we need from you

To be successful in this role, you will need:

- Experience - you have previously worked in a similar role or keen to learn.
- Strength – this role is a physical role where you will be on your feet and working outdoors.
- Flexibility – Availability to work Mondays and Fridays. Other shifts will be set by negotiation.
- Can do attitude – wanting to support our team members and roll up your sleeves
- Detail – a great eye for detail and wanting everything to be perfectly in its place

- Full working rights for Australia (sponsorship is unfortunately not an option).
